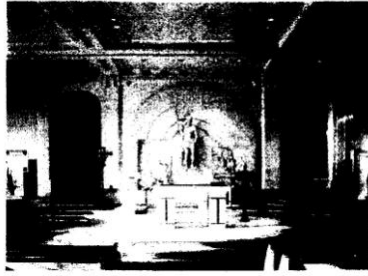

## From the Pastor's Desk



My dear parishioners,

### ***A blessed Easter to you and all your loved ones.***

Looking past the candy, the flowers, the bunnies, and the chicks, there is a richness to Easter that the Church invites us to personalize year after year. It was for us that He came.

In contemplating Jesus' Resurrection, we may ask ourselves which of the three Gospel witnesses we personally identify with, and why. Do we identify with Mary Magdalene, whose love and compassion couldn't wait to arrive at the complete truth about Jesus? Or do we identify with Peter who acted impetuously, but wholeheartedly, and who seemed to have no insight into the meaning of this event? Or do we identify with John who loved greatly and generously believed? We have the opportunity to ask ourselves those questions in light of renewing our baptismal promises. And the answers should highlight not just the extent of our belief, but the extent of our love. After all, that is what Easter is all about.

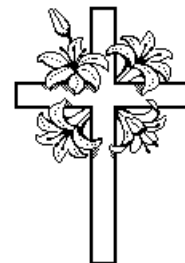
